



LGBT HIP Group Volunteer

LGBT HIP is supporting the set-up of an LGBT Disabled Persons Group. The group currently meets once a month, either in a café or in a meeting room in central Brighton. We are looking for a volunteer who can support the group by:

- Setting dates for meetings and publicising the group by email and on facebook
- Help facilitate a small monthly peer-led group
- Welcome people and be the point of contact for the group
- Write brief notes from meetings to send to members who are not able to attend
- Use technology such as Skype to improve access to the meetings

Volunteers will receive an induction at LGBT Switchboard and will be able to access local training opportunities. The volunteer will work closely with the LGBT HIP Project Manager, and be offered regular supervision and support.

Reasonable expenses, such as bus tickets to get to the group, will be reimbursed.
